Billing and Fees: My fees are \$200.00 for the initial intake session (90 minutes), \$175.00 for individual sessions, parent consultations and family sessions (55 minutes.) Any court or phone consultations requested on behalf of the client will also be billed at \$175.00 per hour. Any written reports will be billed at \$175.00 per hour of preparation. For court testimony my minimum charge is \$500.00. Full payment for the session is the client's responsibility and is requested at the beginning of each session, unless other arrangements are made in advance. I accept some insurance plans. If you have insurance, I will bill your insurance company. If you use insurance and your insurance requires a copayment amount, that amount should be paid at the beginning of each session. Any other payment agreements must be made and agreed to in advance. Appointments cancelled with less than 24 hours advanced notice will be charged a \$155.00 fee. Please speak to me about any questions or difficulties regarding fees.

Billing is contracted with PBS Billing Services. All confidentiality and medical privacy laws apply to this contract. If you have questions about your balance or other billing questions you may contact PBS by phone (541) 343-8122.
